

# Cracker Country



Cracker Country, located on the Florida State Fairgrounds, is Tampa's only living history museum. Founded in 1978 by Mildred W. and Doyle E. Carlton Jr., with the purpose of preserving Florida's rural history, the museum includes a collection of 13 buildings dating from 1870 to 1912.

The structures, which were relocated from across the state of Florida, range from the Okahumpka Train Depot to private homes once occupied by the Carltons and Smiths.

Cracker Country provides a beautiful rural setting designed to create lasting memories for any occasion that can be enhanced by a special and unique atmosphere.
