

ENTRY DELIVERY & PICK-UP

Adult Divisions (Ages 18+): \$5 Per Entry

Late Entry: \$10 Per Entry

ENTRY FEES ARE NON-REFUNDABLE

GUIDELINES

- Only two (2) entries per class may be entered by any one individual.
- · Items submitted should match the division, class, and description listed on the entry form.
- Entered items may be offered for sale at the option of the exhibitor, however, all entered items must remain on exhibition until 11:00 a.m. on Tuesday, February 17, 2026.
- · Identical items cannot be entered into more than one Division or State Fair competition.
- Each adult exhibitor will receive one (1) admission ticket to the Fair.
- · Entries previously exhibited in the Florida State Fair may not be submitted for competition.
- Exhibited work must be completed within the last two (2) years.
- Entries must have been prepared/made/ processed by the exhibitor in whose name they are entered.
- Entries completed by two or more individuals are permitted but will be counted as one exhibitor (the individual who completed the entry form).
- All entries will be displayed at the Fair whether they receive an award or not. In keeping with the
 Florida State Fair's family orientation, items of an offensive, controversial, or objectionable nature or
 subject matter will not be accepted.

ELIGIBILITY

- The Woodturning Novice Division is open to all Florida residents ages 18 and up, who have entry level skills in woodturning. After entering the Florida State Fair for 2 years, at the novice level or having received two (2) 1st place award or Best of Show, the woodturner must advance and compete at the Woodturning Advanced Division.
- The Woodturning Advanced Divisions are open to all Florida residents ages 18 and up. No prerequisite for entry.

JUDGING & AWARDS

- The Fair selects judges who are experienced and knowledgeable in the categories they are assigned. Judges are expected to be fair and unbiased. They may reassign an entry to a different division or class if they feel it's a better fit.
- All entries will be judged using a scorecard to help ensure fairness and consistency. Judges' decisions are final.
- If the judge feels that an entry does not meet the standards for an award, no ribbon or prize will be given, even if it is the only entry in the class.
- · Winners and final displays will be announced during the Fair.

JUDGING CRITERIA

Design (40%)

Form, balance, weight, proportion, uniform wall thickness

Craftsmanship & Execution (60%)

Lack of Tool marks, scratches, etc., and appropriate finish material.
Uniform Wall Thickness
Quality of Finish, Embellishments
& Segmentation

WOODCARVING DEFINITIONS

Hollow Vessel is a form with a top opening smaller than the width, containing a substantial hollow area.

Vase is a hollow vessel higher than it is wide.

Standard hollow vessel or vase – may contain decoration while turning on the lathe (i.e. coves, beads, surface texture).

Embellished hollow vessel or vase – carved, fluted, wood burned, inlay, colored, etc.

Bowl is a form with a top opening is larger than the base, exposing the interior to view (Wider than high).

Standard bowl - may contain decoration applied while turning on the lathe (i.e. coves, beads, surface texture).

Embellished bowl – carved, fluted, wood burned, inlay, colored, etc.

Plate/platter is a form that is substantially wider than high with the surface open to view.

Standard plate/platter – may contain decoration while turning on the lathe (i.e. coves, beads, surface texture.

Embellished plate/platter - carved, fluted, wood burned, inlay, colored, etc.

Spindle is a form primarily turned between centers with grain parallel to lathe bed.

All segmented or constructed is a form that is pieced together and turned with one or more woods (e.g. maple/walnut).

Other than wood is a form made of at least 50% other material (alabaster, plastics, metal spinning, soapstone, and combinations of the above).

Miniature is a form where no dimension exceeds 2".

All ornamental pieces are done with an ornamental type lathe.

Lidded container is a form where the interior is concealed by a removable lid.

Other Not Listed can be jewelry, Christmas ornaments, utensils, constructed multiple turnings, resulting in spinning wheels, ships, wheel clocks, candelabra, reassembled turnings, wood or non-woods acceptable; however, 50% of project must be turned.

GENERAL RULES

DISCLAIMER

All entries are submitted at the exhibitor's own risk. The Florida State Fair is not responsible for any loss, damage, or theft of exhibits even if caused by staff, volunteers, contractors, or visitors. If you want insurance for your entry, you must arrange it through your personal insurance provider before the Fair. Reasonable care will be taken to protect exhibits. No unauthorized people are allowed in the building after closing hours.

DIVISION OR CLASS CANCELLATION

The Florida State Fair may cancel any division or class if there are not enough entries to ensure fair competition. Any affected entries will be returned.

ENTRY ERRORS

Exhibitors are responsible for making sure their entries are correct. This includes online forms and summary sheets. The Fair is not responsible for correcting mistakes, and no awards will be given for entries disqualified due to exhibitor error. If an award is later found to be ineligible, it will be withheld or recovered. You may appeal a disqualification in writing within 90 days of being notified. Include your name, address, full entry details, and your reason for requesting a review.

PREMIUM PAYMENTS

Prizes will be awarded based on the Judging Criteria Record Sheets. Prize checks are void 6 months after the date on the check. No replacement checks will be issued after that, so please cash them promptly.

SUBSTITUTIONS

If needed, substitutions must be made within the same department as the original entry. They must be completed by the last day of the entry delivery period. You may not transfer your entry to another person.

PREVIOUSLY ENTERED ITEMS

Entries that have been shown at past Florida State Fairs are not allowed, except for entries in Horticulture and Aquarium Beautiful.

VERIFICATION OF ENTRY

To confirm that your mailed entry form and fees were received, include a self-addressed stamped envelope with your submission. Online entries will receive a confirmation code after submitting.

RESPONSIBILITY FOR EXHIBITS

The Fair is not responsible for exhibits left behind after the scheduled pick-up time. **Anything left after** that time will be treated as abandoned and discarded by April 1st of the same year.

ENTRY REMOVAL

Once accepted, entries cannot be removed until the official release date listed in the Competition Handbook. Early removal is only allowed in cases like serious illness, emergencies, or at the Fair's discretion.

RETURNED OR BOUNCED CHECKS

A \$25 fee applies to any returned checks. This must be paid with cash, a certified check, or a money order.

MAILING PAPER ENTRY FORMS

<u>Entry Forms must be postmarked by Friday, December 5, 2025.</u> Failure to complete any portion of the entry form may result in disqualification. <u>Late entries must be postmarked before December 12, 2025.</u> If you're submitting a late entry form, you must include the extra \$5 per entry fee. <u>Make checks payable</u> **to:** Florida State Fair Authority

SHIPPING ENTRIES

Shipped entries must arrive no later than January 6, 2026. Packages MUST include Shipping form and prepaid shipping label. Entries will be shipped back to the exhibitors after the fair in the same container. Return shipping costs are the responsibility of the entrant.

All entries not claimed by April 1st of the same year will be recycled, disposed or donated through our program department. Entries not picked up on designated dates can be arranged for a special pick-up appointment by emailing CreativeLiving@floridastatefair.com.

EXHIBIT DESIGN & SET UP

The Florida State Fair controls how exhibits are displayed. If your entry is meant to be hung but isn't ready to hang, the Fair will display it as they see fit. No changes can be made once items are on display. Exhibitors cannot handle their entries after drop-off. Fair staff will handle final placement and assembly, using any instructions you provide. If your item needs assembly or disassembly, include clear instructions and diagrams. The Fair may use pins or other tools to secure your exhibit for display. Online entries will receive a confirmation code after submitting.
