Each approved organization will receive a \$350 donation for their booth display after the completion of the 2026 Florida State Fair.

#### **New Display Concepts:**

Displays can take on any format or layout that fits safely within the assigned area. Think beyond the average footprint, create something that draws people in and sparks curiosity! This could include:

- Themed garden vignettes or plant scenes
- Educational or interactive
- Artistic or whimsical horticulture installations
- Collaborative projects highlighting your mission
- Seating Areas/Benches
